MINIATURIST LIZ SONTAG AKA TINKY

We are so excited to feature the work of one of Melbourne's best miniaturist artists, Tinky, at this year's festival. Tinky gathers vintage objects and assembles them with figurines and word play to create humorous dioramas. Miniature construction workers might gather to fix a broken egg shell, or emergency workers may tend to the victim of a giant cigarette butt. It has been said that Tinky's miniature dioramas add a sense of surprise and wonder to the streets, with unlikely installations on a pipe or window sill, in a gutter, or a hole-in-the-wall.
